These specifications concern the B.EPT3Ang.Mp module.
The paper is due by email by midnight of **Friday 28 August**.

Requirements

Your paper should

- comprise no fewer than 3,500 and no more than 5,000 words
- concern any aspect of early Germanic religion
- refer to primary texts in the original language, whose quotations should be accompanied by translations (your own or cited from a scholarly source)
- engage directly with at least one Old Germanic language (by providing your own translations or discussing original-language concepts)
- use at least half a dozen secondary sources
- make consistent use of a prominent humanities stylesheet ([MLA](#), [CMOS](#), or [MHRA](#))
