

## Clause Analysis

Divide each of the following sentences into clauses; identify headclause(s) and subclause(s); and then, for each clause separately, parse for clause elements S(ubject), V(erb), (O)bject, A(dverbial), and (C)omplement, specifying  $V_{aux}$ ,  $V_{non-fin}$ ,  $O_d$ ,  $O_i$ ,  $C_s$ , and  $C_o$  where necessary to avoid ambiguity. Example:

Headclause: S V O  
I thought you had already eaten.  
Subclause: S  $V_{aux}$  A  $V_{non-fin}$   
you had already eaten.

1. While you dallied, I made us lunch.
2. Are you sure or will you reconsider?
3. I am leaving, as no one has need of me here.
4. No one has seen Eva since she won the lottery.
