

Clause Analysis

Divide each of the following sentences into clauses; identify headclause(s) and subclause(s); and then, for each clause separately, parse for clause elements S(ubject), V(erb), (O)bject, A(dverbial), and (C)omplement, specifying V_{aux} , $V_{non-fin}$, O_d , O_i , C_s , and C_o where necessary to avoid ambiguity. Example:

Headclause:	S	V	O			
	I	thought	you	had	already	eaten.
Subclause:		S	V_{aux}	A	$V_{non-fin}$	
		you	had	already	eaten.
